ORDER

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on Plaintiff's Agreed Motion to Extend Temporary Restraining Order and Asset Freeze, and to Continue Show Cause Hearing (DE [25], wherein Plaintiff requests, with the agreement of *pro se* Defendant Johanna M. Garcia ("Garcia") and the Court-appointed Receiver over MJ Capital LLC and MJ Taxes and More, Inc. (together with Garcia, "Defendants") to: (1) extend the temporary restraining order and asset freeze over Defendants through September 9, 2021, or such later date that the Court enters a ruling on the SEC's request for a preliminary injunction against Defendants; and (2) continue the August 25, 2021 hearing wherein Defendants must show cause why a preliminary injunction should not be entered against them. For the reasons provided in the Agreed Motion and being otherwise duly advised it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Agreed Motion (DE [25]) is **GRANTED** as follows:

I. TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the temporary restraining order over Defendants entered by the Court on August 11, 2021 (DE [16]) is hereby extended through September 9, 2021, or such later date that the Court enters a ruling on the SEC's request for a preliminary injunction against Defendants.


II. ASSET FREEZE

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the asset freeze over Defendants entered by the Court on August 11, 2021 (DE [16]) is hereby extended through September 9, 2021, or such later date that the Court enters a ruling on the SEC's request for a preliminary injunction against Defendants.

III. SHOW CAUSE HEARING

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a hearing is before the Honorable Raag Singhal on **Wednesday, September 8, 2021, at 1:30 p.m.**, for Defendants to show cause, if any, why a Preliminary Injunction pursuant to Rule 65 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure should not be granted against Defendants, as requested by the Commission. The hearing will be conducted via ZOOM Video Conference. Instructions to appear by ZOOM Video Conference will be forthcoming.
